

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR VISITING SCHOLARS (no patient treatment)

The following is a memorandum of understanding between the University of Louisville School of Dentistry hereafter known as the "School" and

Alex Labossiere hereafter known as a "Visiting Scholar". The purpose of this memorandum is to set forth the mutual understandings between the School and the Visiting Scholar (no patient treatment). A Visiting Scholar (no patient treatment) is defined as a student, faculty, or staff member from another academic or research institution that has come to the School to pursue a course of research or teaching for a limited time period.

1. ***Term***

The memorandum of understanding will begin on or about 09/01/2024 and extend for a period of 1 year. It may be renewed one time if mutually agreed by the School and Visiting Scholar.

2. ***Purpose of Visit***

The Visiting Scholar shall be engaged in (describe teaching or research activity):

Alex will perform research in the M. Ramsey lab towards his PhD. This research focuses on bacterial interaction in the human oral microbiome. He will only be participating in research and dissertation writing during this year.

3. ***ULSD Faculty Scholar***

The Visiting Scholar shall be sponsored by Dr. Matthew Ramsey within the Department of Oral Immunology and Infectious Disease (OIID).

4. ***The School's Obligations***

The school may provide the Visiting Scholar with:

1. Office space, if available.
2. Administrative support for routine correspondence.
3. Computer access, Outlook account, and guest ID.
4. Office supplies.
5. Library access.

The School will not supply major equipment or supplies unless purchased through an existing faculty member's or departmental grant or contract. The Department in which the Visiting Scholar is working may elect to provide some travel support to professional meetings, but this support should only be funded from restricted funds and not general funds.

5. ***The Visiting Scholar***

The Visiting Scholar agrees to provide the following to support himself/herself while in residence at the School.

1. Housing costs
2. Living expenses including health insurance
3. Travel from principal residence
4. Purchase of specialized equipment or supplies

The visiting scholar makes all arrangements for visas, governmental documents and endorsements to study in the United States and specifically at the University of Louisville School of Dentistry.

6. ***Acceptance of a Visiting Scholar to a teaching/research position at the School does not imply an offer of employment. This is a temporary assignment only for purposes outlined in paragraph 2 above.***

7. Additional agreements between the School and the Visiting Scholar shall be known as addenda to this memorandum.


